- All Persons with Visual Impairment (PWVI)
- All Government agencies

- All religious and non-religious organizations
- Community organizations including (NGOs, CBOs, SHGs).

### Benefits to Members

- Members have a voting right during Annual General Meetings (AGM) and have a management say on KSB governance and programme matters
- Members receive a membership certificate that have profiled many to obtain foreign visa; jobs,
- Members receive a copy of the Annual Report with narrative and financial analysis
- Members receive subsidized in Eye Care and Optical services and may benefit from occasional free gifts
- Members have opportunities to participate in Charity Events like mountain climbing; Golf and Fishing tournaments.
- Members have an opportunity to sponsor, interact and mentor children with visual impairment.
